Lineage of cells: human endometrial adenocarcinoma

Donor information: 39 year old female

Karyotype: Unknown

Media and passaging conditions: Cells are passaged 1:5 every 4 days in DMEM-F12 + 8% FBS + 1mM NEAAs + 10mM Sodium pyruvate.

Serum starvation and treatment with estradiol/tamoxifen. All cells are cultured 72hrs in phenol-red free DMEM-F12 + 8% charcoal-stripped serum prior to hormone treatment. Cells treated with vehicle (ethanol), 10nM 17b-estradiol, or 100nM 4-OH Tamoxifen for 30 minutes.
